## Jigsaw 2: Never Give Up! Discussion Guide

*This is intended to be used in classrooms within twenty-four hours of the assembly program.*

Allow 15-20 minutes to discuss the following questions:

1. What do you think was best in the assembly program? Why?
2. What are some risks in life worth taking? Why?
3. What are some risks not worth taking? Why?
4. Sometimes it comes down to knowing how far to go or when to stop. Can we list some guidelines to help make our choices clearer?

(Try to get them to talk about categories such as endangering others, endangering themselves, making future changes difficult or impossible, etc.)

5. What are some things that you should always try to do, no matter how difficult it might be, or how many times you have failed?

(After listing different things, say something to this effect):

*“Just remember that we often need to keep trying to achieve the same results by trying different things or using different approaches.”*

*“Insanity: doing the same thing over and over again and expecting different results.” -Albert Einstein*

6. What is the difference between perseverance and stubbornness?

(After some discussion, make this summary):

*A stubborn person is unwilling to change or make adjustments.*

*A person who perseveres will work toward a good thing no matter what changes or adjustments may be necessary.*
