Number of Teams: 4, most of the time. (red, green, yellow, blue)

For Gym or Multi-purpose room, please provide:

- 2 tables (7 to 10 feet) for Game Show Equipment
- A projection screen
- Have students sitting on the floor in separate teams
- If you are able to provide chairs for every student, please provide four additional tables for answer boxes.

For Auditorium, please provide:

- Students sitting in their separate teams
- A projection screen
- 6 tables (7 to 10 feet): 1 table per team for answer boxes, and 2 tables for game show equipment.
