Audience: PreK-6

Presentation Time: 45 to 50 minutes

Capacity: 400

Set-Up Time: 30 minutes minimum; 45 to 60 minutes preferred.

Take-Down Time: 20 to 30 minutes

Arrival: 45 to 60 minutes before presentation time. No assistance is needed beyond accessibility to performance area.

Assembly Requirements: A portable whiteboard, blackboard, or easel with paper. One power outlet with reasonable range of performance area. A small table and chair. A bottle of water. Students should sit on the floor, with a center aisle between them.

Performer Provides: Eric will provide his own sound system and all related cords, microphones, etc. A copy of Eric's DVD for your school library will be sent ahead of time, free of charge, upon request. If classrooms wish to show some of the videos from the DVD in anticipation of Eric's assembly, that is encouraged and can be helpful for increasing the excitement about his arrival, but is not necessary.
